WIN Learning offers Essential Soft Skills Courseware and Work Ready Courseware as a Local Area Network (LAN) installation to provide learners with workforce education resources without an internet connection.

WIN Learning's LAN courseware
gives users access to the WIN Career Readiness System,
where learners can work through the courseware and track their progress,
and administrators can create and manage classes, monitor learners' progress, and view
reports on classes or individual learners. Once the WIN Learning Courseware is installed on the server,
it can be accessed using the browser on the computers on the network. The WIN Learning LAN
Courseware can also be installed locally on individual computers. The Work Ready Courseware and the
Essential Soft Skills Courseware can be purchased and installed together as a package or purchased
separately if administrators choose to offer just one course.

Work Ready Courseware is ideal for measuring competency in foundational skills that focus on the core communication, reasoning, and problem-solving skills required for 21st century opportunities, from entry-level to professional.

The Work Ready Courseware can be accessed at up to five different skill levels that align to the US Department of Labor's O*NET Job Zones Framework. All content addresses core skills required for entry into all 16 national career clusters at varying skill levels designated by the O*NET job zones. Instructional content is presented along with exercises and checkpoints to measure and demonstrate learning gains, all within a career context. Learners always have the option to review previous levels and rework exercises for additional practice.

The WIN Learning Work Ready Courseware consists of three modules:

Work Ready Math builds mathematical reasoning and problem-solving skills to prepare learners to solve reallife workplace problems, such as calculating dimensions, costs, and percentages.

Work Ready Reading builds reading comprehension and reasoning skills to prepare learners to utilize documents in the workplace. Skills include obtaining and applying new vocabulary and following complex instructions.

Work Ready Data builds analytical skills to prepare learners to interpret sources of data in the workplace. Skills include identifying trends among variables and drawing conclusions from one or more sources of data.
